

Scope of Work

Item 1

This item includes mobilization, pothole of the existing 24" RCP at the point of connection, site cleanup, and demobilization.

Item 2

This item includes the installation of the first Inlet Structure. Includes connection to the existing 24" RCP Line and an 8' tall U-52 Cristy Box with non-traffic rated grate, steps, and side drain per detail D-14.

Item 3

This item includes the installation of the 12" PVC SDR-26 Pipe between the structures.

Item 4

This item includes the installation of the second Metered Inlet Structure. Includes an 3' tall U-52 Cristy Box with non-traffic rated grate.

Item 5

This item includes the installation of the 4" Thick 3,000 PSI Concrete Pad. The assumed dimensions of this pad are off the Tract No. 288 Drawing provided. It scales around 20' wide x 45' long. The detail for the Pad D-13, indicates that the concrete is 3,000 PSI concrete w/ polypropylene fiber reinforcing fibermesh 300 or equal.

Clarifications

- 1. This proposal is valid for 30 days from date of this letter.
- 2. This proposal is based on standard 8-hour workdays. No overtime, weekend, or holiday work has been allowed.
- 3. This budget is based on the drawings TRACT No. 288 and details provided.
- 4. We reserve the right to revise this pricing based on Final Drawings, and Specifications.
- 5. This proposal excludes payment and performance bonds. If required, add <u>0.5%</u> to the price above.
- 6. Schedule of work is subject to an approved agreeable schedule between the Owner and W. M. Lyles Co.
- 7. This proposal is based on mutually agreeable contract terms and conditions.

- 2. Liquidated damages and/or acceleration.
- 3. All permits and associated fees including but not limited to:
 - a. Storm water pollution prevention plan, permits, fees or implementation.
 - b. Dust control plan, permits, fees.
 - c. California Regional Water Quality Control Board permits, fees, discharge requirements.
 - d. Encroachment permits
- 4. Survey including, but not limited to:
 - a. Survey monument preservation/replacement.
 - b. Any Initial or final survey.
 - c. Control, layout, and staking.
- 5. Landscape, and irrigation.
- 6. Pipe and/or Equipment insulation.
- 7. Corrosion Protection
- 8. Shut downs, dewatering, or bypassing of systems.
- 9. Mitigation of Groundwater (if encountered).
- 10. Mitigation of Hazardous Materials (if encountered).
- 11. American Iron & Steel (AIS), Buy America, Buy American or any similar domestic material requirements.

General Terms and Conditions

- 1. This proposal includes costs for typical insurance policies: General Liability (\$2 million) 4 million) and Automobile Liability (\$2 million) with additional insured as requested along with standard Worker's Compensation (\$1 million) coverage. Additional insurance coverage that is requested or any payment of deductibles may be at an additional cost.
- 2. By law, the duty to indemnify shall not extend to the acts of willful misconduct, active, or sole negligence, on the part of the Owner or anyone associated with him including design or engineering work submitted for our Scope.
- 3. If hazardous materials, unsuitable ground conditions, change in soil conditions or concealed conditions are encountered, we will cease all operations and the Owner will determine the nature and extent of such conditions, and will recommend the nature and extent of remediation. Any hazardous materials, unsuitable ground conditions, change in soil conditions or concealed conditions that are encountered shall be considered "extra work" under an approved Change Order.
- 4. Any authorized cost plus or force account work shall be completed under written direction per the agreed time and material section within the contractual documents or in absence, using our annual and most current labor and equipment rates along with our time and material calculation sheet.
- 5. In the absence of Dispute Resolution provisions in the contractual documents, any and all claims, controversies or disputes arising out of or relating to this agreement, or the breach thereof, which remain unresolved after good-faith and direct negotiations between the on-site Project Managers and after with the Corporate Officer(s) and authorized representative of the Owner (parties), shall then be submitted to confidential mediation with written notice in accordance with the rules and procedures for mediation then in effect under either JAMS for Mediation or the Construction Industry Mediation Rules of the American Arbitration Association. Continuing claims, controversies or disputes thereafter shall be submitted to binding Arbitration as allowed by California Law.

- 6. In the absence of warranty provisions in the Contract Documents, Contractor warrants to Owner that all materials and equipment furnished shall be new unless otherwise specified and that all work under this Agreement will be performed in a good and workmanlike manner, shall be of good quality, free from faults and defects for a period of one (1) year from the date of W.M. Lyles Co.'s scope of work completion.
