This is a reminder about the survey we recently sent to all farm units in the Madera County GSA within the Madera Subbasin, concerning project rates. You can complete the paper survey and mail it back to us, or you can scan it and email it to_WNR@maderacounty.com by **August 31, 2024**.

This survey is part of a board-directed initiative discussed in our July meeting to analyze these rates. The survey builds on the 2022 rate study, with updated costs for the same projects.

Dear Valued Farmer:

The Board of Supervisors (acting as the Board of Directors for the County GSA) is exploring ways to your groundwater rates in the County GSA, Madera Subbasin, including pursuing grants, looking for measures, and evaluating partnerships. If a temporary injunction on groundwater rates is lifted, the E assess a lower alternative rate for projects in addition to the GSA Admin Fee. Along with a potential rates comes a smaller scale of projects and a corresponding reduction in expected 2040 allocations table of potential rates. All alternatives are subject to additional review. Please indicate your prefere tear off and mail the postcard back or take a picture and email it to the address provided. Results of will be presented to the Board of Supervisors acting as the Board of Directors in September 2024.

GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY PLAN (GSP) REVISIONS OVERVIEW

As of August 2024, the Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs) in the Chowchilla Strevised the Subbasin GSP on three occasions. Following is a brief summary of the revisional various sections of the GSP.

GSP REVISIONS COMPLETED IN JULY 2022 Addressed the potential deficiencies identified by DWR in their January 20 and discussed during five DWR consultation meetings between December 2 summarized the progressive implementation actions taken by the GSAs sin GSP in January 2020; recognized the Subbasin GSAs' clear and formal com implement a Domestic Well Mitigation Program beginning no later than Jan the execution of a memorandum of understanding (MOU); and reaffirmed cimplementing the GSP and achieving sustainable groundwater conditions by

GSP REVISIONS COMPLETED IN MAY 2023 Resolved the remaining deficiencies identified by DWR in their March 2023 related to groundwater levels and subsidence through establishment of mosustainable management criteria related to groundwater levels and subside Subbasin; reaffirmed commitment to upholding the Human Right to Water manage groundwater in the Subbasin for all beneficial uses and users; provinceognize the launch and current status of the Domestic Well Mitigation Prothe benefits of projects and management actions to all sustainability indication further efforts to implement projects and management actions since Ju GSP implementation will achieve sustainable groundwater conditions by 20 SGMA.

GSP REVISIONS COMPLETED IN AUGUST 2024 Amended the Domestic Well Mitigation Program to include mitigation for wan MOU between the GSAs and the Chowchilla Management Zone; complete infrastructure review and revised subsidence SMC; and developed a Demai Subsidence MOU.
