New Funding Opportunity from USDA



Update on MLRP

The MLRP workshops and pre-applications have generated considerable interest, indicating a strong desire to engage with the program. In particular, the Madera MLRP has received a large number of applications, which are currently being reviewed. MEASUREMENT

Update on the 2024 Verification Project

The final data collection for the Verification Project is scheduled for January 2025, marking the conclusion of this phase. This final round of data gathering will be crucial for verifying the accuracy of all previous information and ensuring the accuracy and reliability of all previously collected information. It will allow the team to finalize the data set and provide a complete and reliable analysis of the project's findings.
