Guiding Principles

- Avoid a probationary hearing before the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) and get back to the Department of Water Resources (DWR) as soon as possible.
- Keep our foot on the gas peddle.





Background

- Original GSP Submitted January 2020
- First Revision Submitted July 2022
- Second Revision Submitted May 2023
- Substantial changes stemming from lengthy discussions with the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB)
 - 2nd Amendment to the Domestic Well Mitigation Program (DWMP)
 - Development of Chowchilla Management Zone Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
 - Development of Demand Management Program and Subsidence MOU
 - Changes to subsidence sustainable management criteria





Background (Cont.....)

- Reviewed changes with the GSP Advisory Committee on August 7, 2024
- Released the 2024 Revised GSP for public review on August 2, 2024
- Public Review Period August 2, 2024 to September 2, 2024 (30 Days)
 - Four comments received from one commenter
- Online Public Workshop Webinar August 16, 2024





2025 Revised GSP

- SWRCB simultaneously reviewed the 2024 Revised GSP and on October 18, 2024 met with the GSAs to review their comments
 - 2 "fix-it ticket" items **DO NOT need to be addressed now**
 - DWMP temporary mitigation response time
 - Interconnected Surface Water all subbasins got a "pass" and SWRCB wants DWR's guidance on ISW
 - 2 "must have" items DO need to be addressed now
 - Delete "same" in the definition of an undesirable result (UR) for the reduction in groundwater storage sustainability indicator
 - Revise UR for groundwater levels concerns about domestic well impacts and want a numerical backstop
 - Slight modifications to the UR Greater than 25% of the RMS (10 (or more) of 36) below the minimum threshold for two consecutive fall measurements
 - Language to be added to the 2024 Revised GSP:
 - If the GWL IMs are revised, in a downward direction, in subsequent Plan Amendments, the GSAs commit that such a revision should not impact more than 75 domestic wells during the implementation period.
 - Reference to development of a Demand Management Program as set-forth in Appendix 3N
